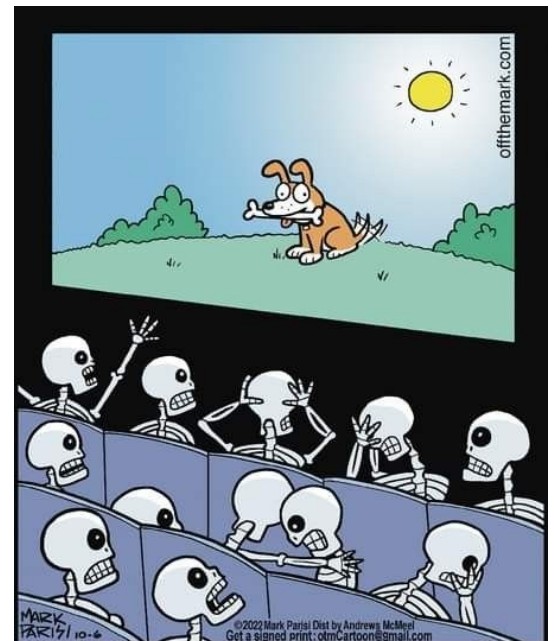

This course is for you if you handle food at church or other events or have a Food Safe Certificate greater than 5 years old.

Note: The Saskatchewan Healthy Authority **requires** retraining every 5 years.

The minimum requirement for the course to be offered is 15 people.

Course Length: 8 Hours (30 min. lunch break)

Registration Cost: \$69.00 (GST included & Food Safe Manual)
