## ALS (Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis)

The designated charity for the month of June is ALS, also known as Lou Gehrig's disease. ALS is a fatal neurodegenerative disease the cause of which is still mostly unknown although it is known a small number of cases are inherited. There is yet no cure nor effective treatment. ALS often begins with muscle twitching and weakness in an arm or leg, trouble swallowing or slurred speech. Eventually ALS affects control of the muscles needed to move, speak, eat and breathe.

Carolynn Drabble's parents moved to McClure Place in September 1994 due to her father's ALS. He died in July 1995. Diane Dodds son-in-law died in 2024 at age 46.
